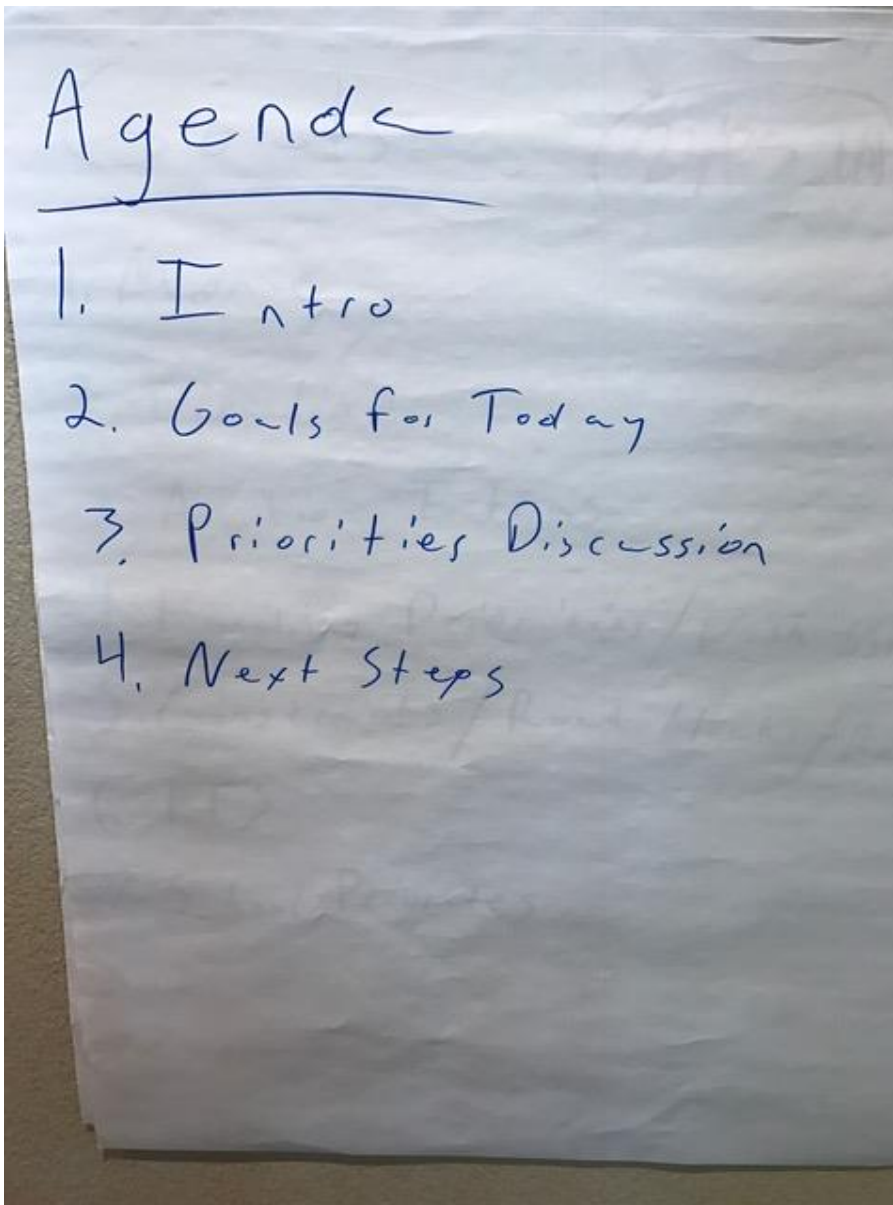

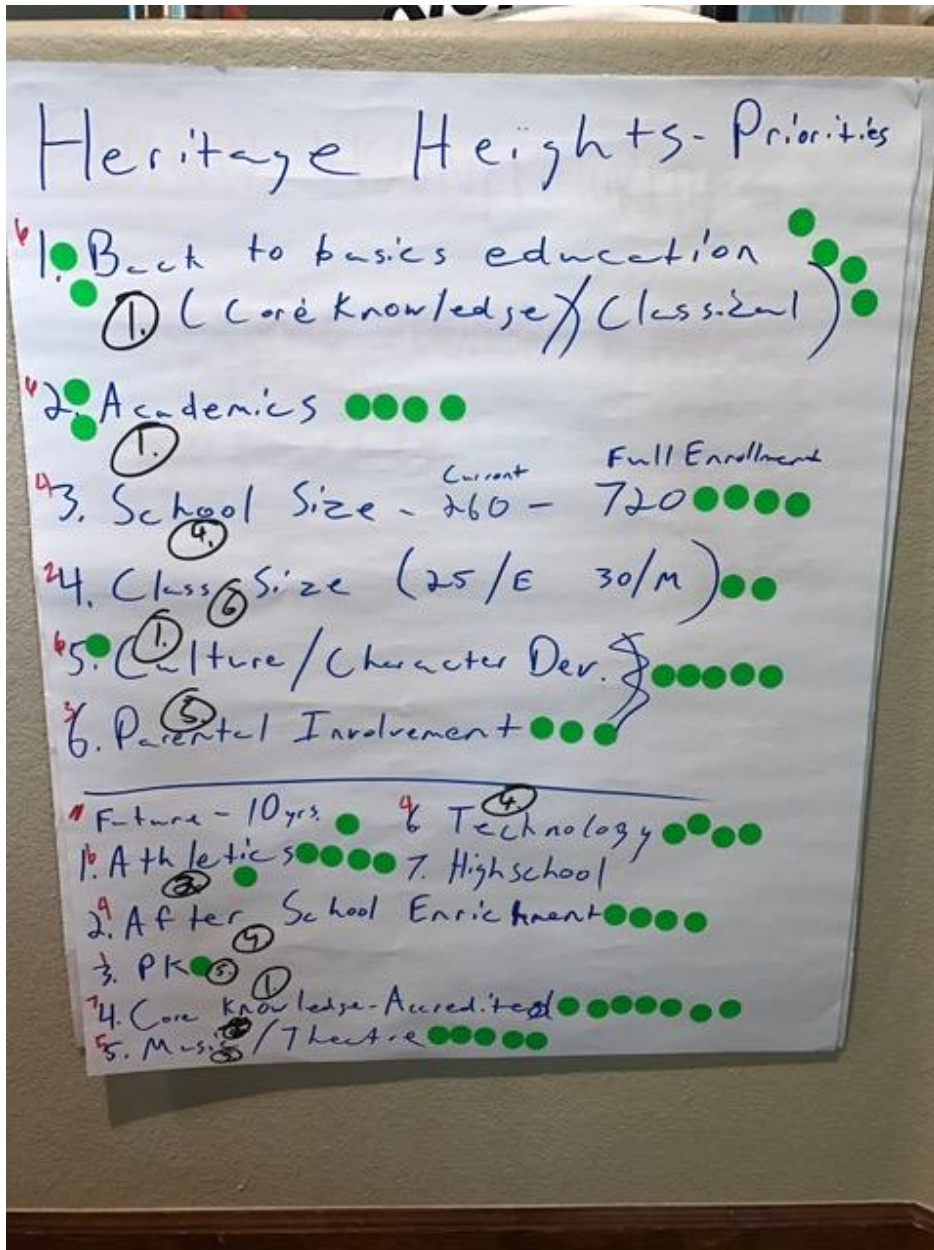
3. Priorities Discussion- lead by Dustin Jones. Discussed priorities. Each attendee put dots on their top priorities.

7. High School (4 votes)

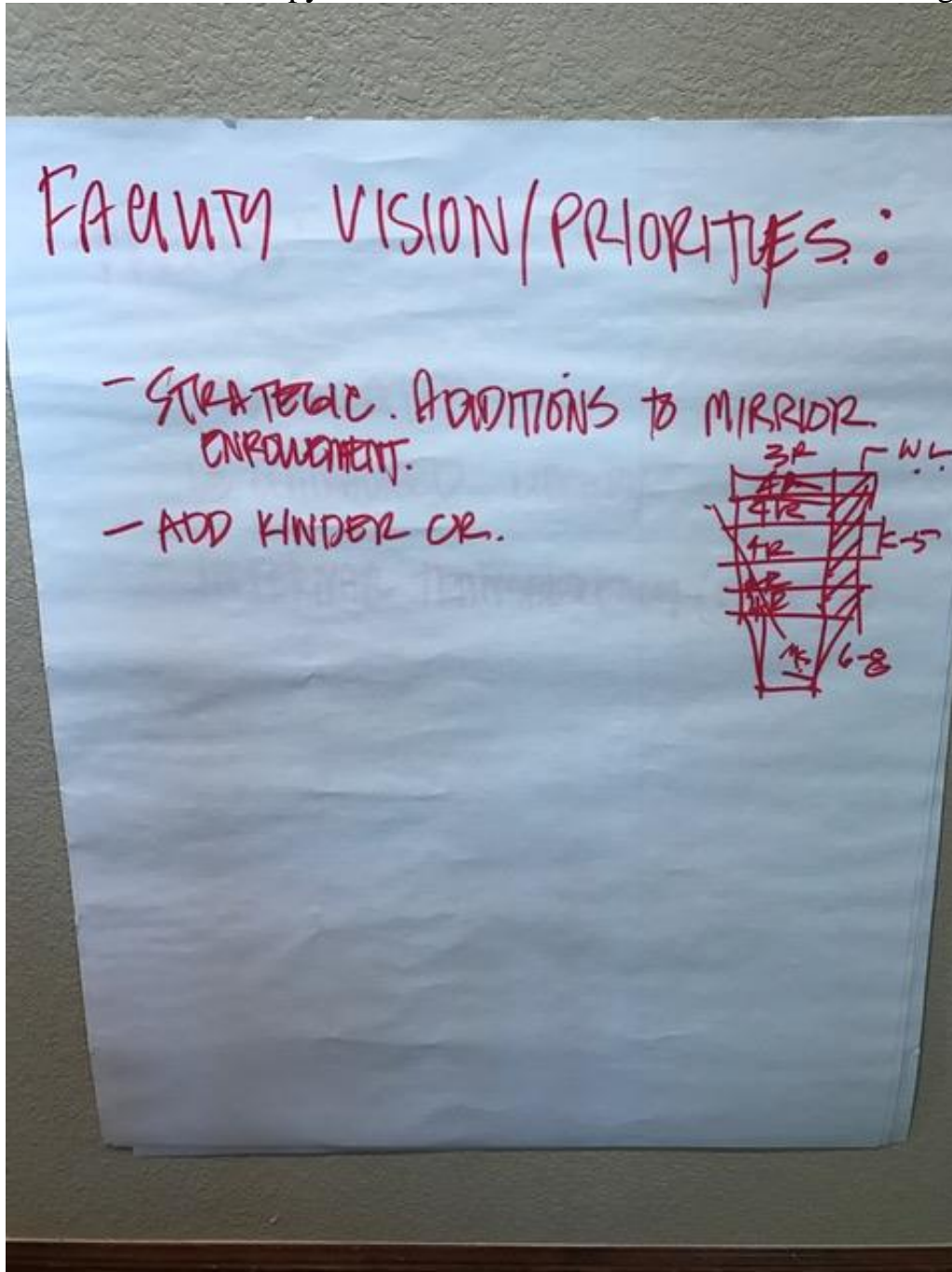


Greg Cromer from DLR Group lead a discussion on various items show in pictures and in type below. Went though what physical things we would like in a facility.

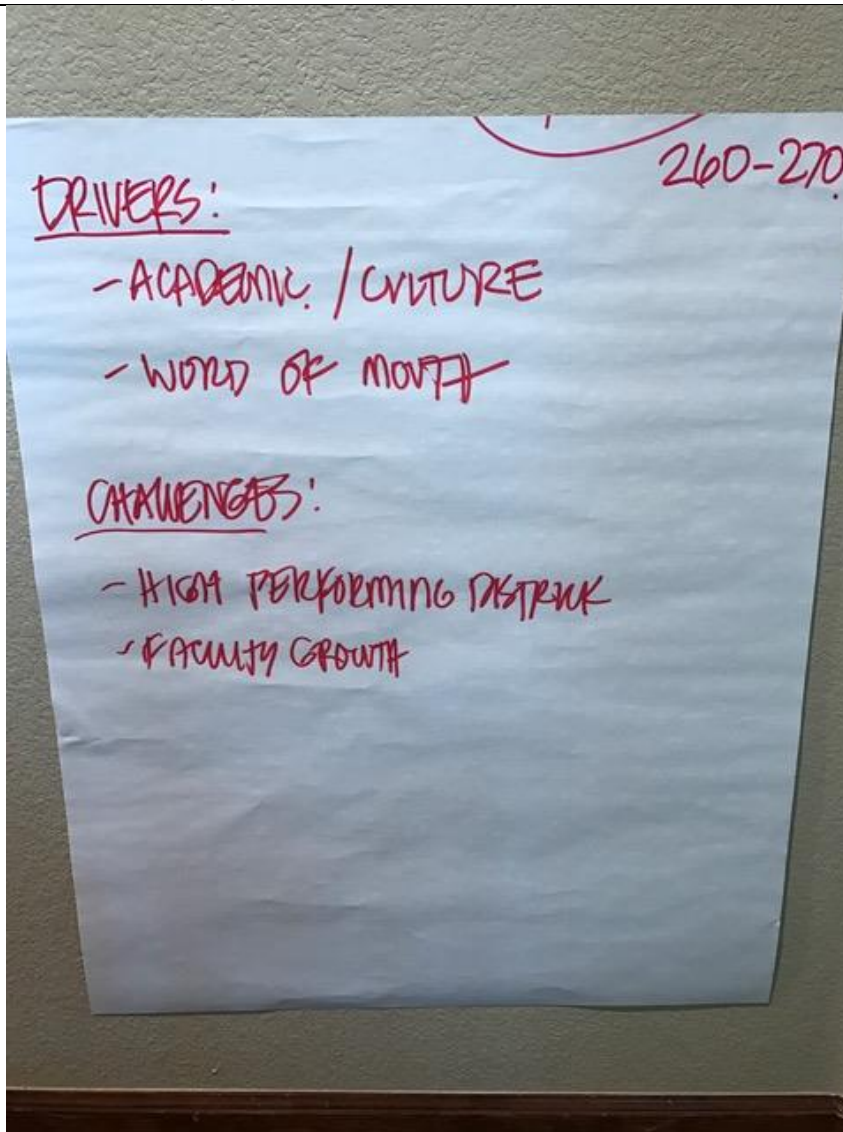
